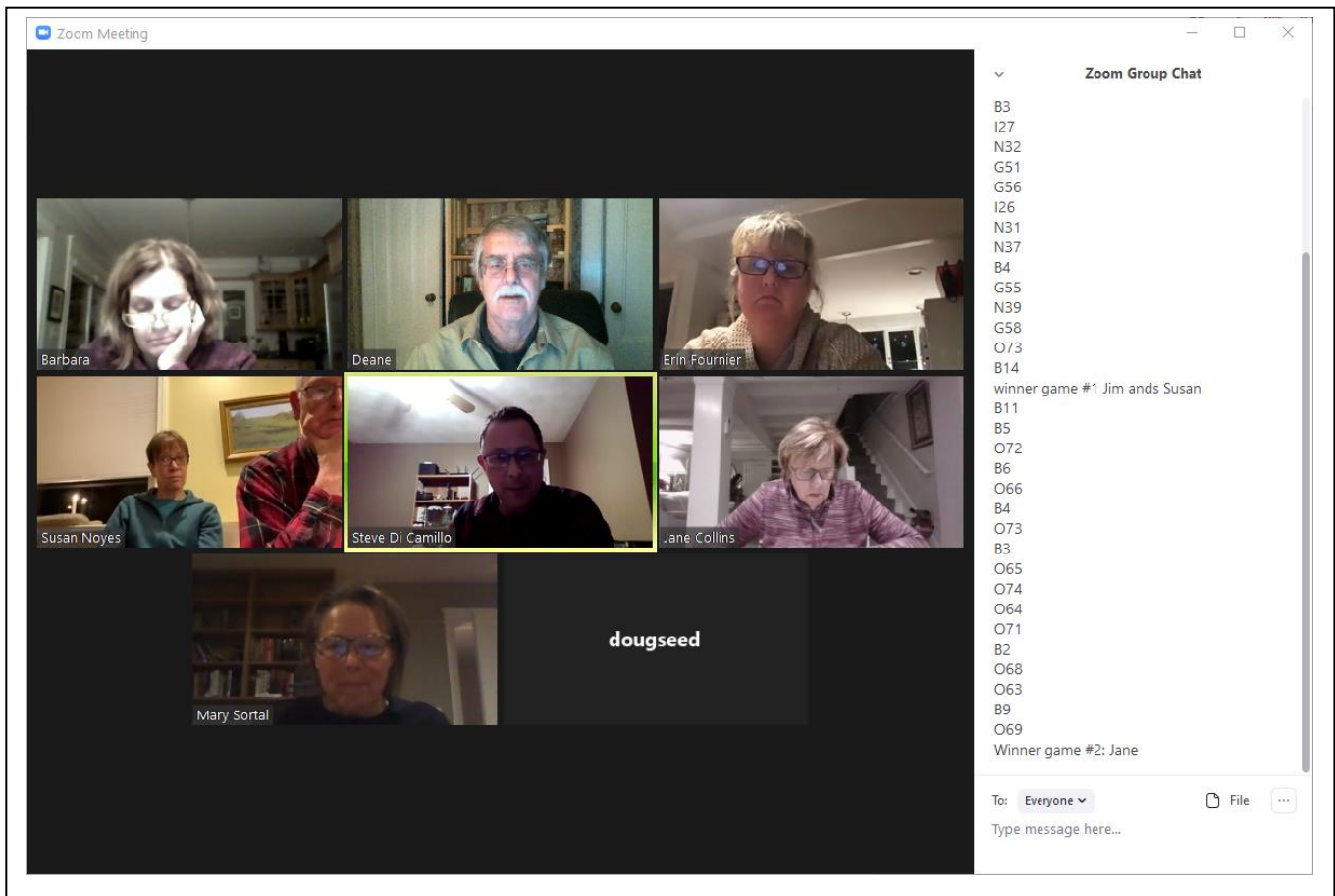


We expect to see Mary cruising around Newburyport next summer in grand style.
